Guiding questions to prepare your project idea



- Where is change necessary?
- Do you see a window of opportunity that you could use?
- Which solutions can you think of?
- Are there other actors that you could join forces with?

Is the solution / project idea both **impactful and feasible**?

STEP 2

Use the following structure to design your project concept.

Project Concept Note

1. The challenge and You

- What is the challenge that you are trying to overcome?
- Why is this important for you?
- What motivates you to act?'

2. Your contribution

- What can you concretely do or offer to bring change?
- What is your impactful and feasible idea?

3. Map the field (important!)

Are there already similar projects that you can learn from or join forces with?

4. Stakeholders

- Who is involved in your idea?
- Which stakeholders have which needs and interests?
- Who do you need to convince for your project to be successful?

5. Resources and network

- Who can support your project?
- What other resources do you need?

6. Milestones

- What are specific and tangible outcomes for your project?

7. First steps

- What are your first steps?
