How To Apply

The exchange application for undergraduate students is entirely online, through our application system called Mundus

The student must contact the Home Institution's international office and ask them to send a nomination with the student's name, email and exact period of interest to the e-mail douglas.bartholomeu@fm.usp.br

The applications will be analyzed by FMUSP International Office and forwarded to our Undergraduate Commission for evaluation in around 30 days after the deadline.

The student will receive an e-mail containing a link to Mundus platform and instructions to complete the application: fill out personal information, select courses and upload some documents.



If the student is accepted, we are going to communicate the student and the Home Institution and send the acceptance letter via e-mail.
