

EUROASPIRE IV - Study

European Survey of Cardiovascular Disease Prevention and Diabetes

The Study Center in Würzburg invites since August 2012 residents from the city and the district of Würzburg and Kitzingen to participate in the EUROASPIRE IV study. The German part of the EUROASPIRE IV study is coordinated by the Comprehensive Heart Failure Center (CHFC) and the Institute of Clinical Epidemiology and Biometry (ICE-B) of the University of Würzburg. The German Study Center of EUROASPIRE IV is located in the epidemiological survey unit of the ICE-B and the CHFC. The data from the study region in Würzburg will be compared with data from 26 European countries. By December 2012 about 500 people with previous evidence for coronary heart disease shall participate. Among participants risk factors for cardiovascular diseases will be documented and cardiac, pulmonary and renal function within the survey unit. In addition, participants will be assessed for early stages of diabetes mellitus and renal insufficiency. In Würzburg also additional information on cardiac function will be investigated.
